Suzanne Wood was born and raised in Idaho and started painting at the age of 12. Her mentor and family friend was the late Archie Teeter, a well know Idaho painter. She has been a studio and gallery artist since she received a degree in fine arts in 1983. In that year she opened and operated a cooperative studio and gallery (Studio 6) until she moved to the Pacific Northwest in 1992. She organized a yearly art show called “Art and Architecture” in cooperation with Holland Reality, Simplot Corporation and the Bank of Idaho.
